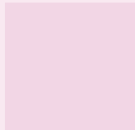

... the charity was started in 1992 to improve the lives of sick children in Gloucestershire. Initially created to fund a new children's hospital for the county, the Appeal now reaches out to help sick children from across Gloucestershire in many different ways. The efforts of thousands of Pied Piper supporters have raised over £2 million to date. The funds have been used to build the new Children's Centre at Gloucestershire Royal Hospital, refurbish and revitalise the Battledown children's ward at Cheltenham General Hospital, purchase new equipment, enhance hospital environments and help individual children to make life at home easier with hoists and other equipment. But the work cannot stop here. Medical advances mean that new and specialised services are continually becoming available and should be offered to our local children. Yet this puts a greater demand on the resources of the NHS in Gloucestershire and it needs our support. So please help us to build a better future for children in sickness and pain across the county.

St Richard's Hospice **Celebrating 25 Years of Care**

... we are proud to be celebrating our silver anniversary in 2009, marking 25 years of offering excellent specialist care, comfort and compassion to our patients and their families living with cancer and other life-threatening illnesses. From small beginnings, the vision of a few to set up a hospice in south Worcestershire became a reality. We now have 145 staff and 800 fantastic volunteers who make St Richard's what it is today. After opening our new hospice in 2006 we achieved a complete package of care for the 1,800 patients and families we see each year including the provision of 24-hour In-patient care, Specialist Palliative Home Care Nurses, Day Hospice, Family Support, physiotherapist, occupational therapist, and complementary therapists. All our services are free to patients and families but we need to raise £4.8m each year to continue with this care, relying on generous donations to raise 70% of this amount, with the remaining 30% provided by the NHS. Thank you for your support with this very special charity event, we greatly appreciate your generosity and we would also like to say that we are absolutely delighted that this year Pershore College has entered a 'Tree of Life' Garden to celebrate our 25th anniversary so please visit them.

The Leukaemia and Intensive Chemotherapy Fund

... is an independent local charity that works to improve the care of patients from Gloucestershire, Herefordshire and south Worcestershire who are receiving intensive chemotherapy for leukaemia, lymphoma and other cancers. We offer financial support to families and fund a clinical psychologist to help these patients come to terms with their disease. Until recently most of our work has been in Cheltenham but our new appeal is to raise £350,000 to redesign, refurbish and extend the Edward Jenner Unit at Gloucester Royal. This will provide a day unit for the administration of both chemotherapy and blood transfusion and will be an enormous help to patients from Gloucester, Stroud and the Forest of Dean. LINC has also purchased a blood analyser for the mobile chemotherapy unit which currently visits Cirencester and Ross on Wye, taking chemotherapy to the patient. The analyser will provide a quick and accurate blood test on the unit prior to treatment making it a one stop treatment. Until this machine was available patients had to make a separate visit to either their GP or local hospital.
